**Pocketbook Mussel** – a clear span truss structure relieves concerns of environmental groups over mussel populations in this Georgia stream



**Deer Crossing** – this animal crossing allows deer to pass safely beneath a busy highway



**Nashville Crayfish** – roadway crossing uses a bottomless precast arch to ensure protection of the Nashville Crayfish



**California Red-Legged Frog** – strict environmental permitting called for a bottomless arch that protects this endangered frog



**Wild Salmon Passage** – a single span, three-sided structure replaces high velocity culverts to provide ideal natural conditions for fish passage and habitat
