5. Contech promotes the use of non-invasive species in Filtterra systems, and has made efforts to maintain a plant list free of invasives. However, always check with local sources, as some species listed (even natives) may be invasive in some regions and not others.

6. All Filtterra vault systems incorporate a ponding depth ranging from 12"-36" between finished grade and media surface. For systems with more than 18" from finished grade to media (FTIBC, FTIBP, FTPD, etc), Contech recommends choosing a species with "Sizing" noted as "XL" or "Tree".
